As members of Kiwanis International we celebrated the organization's 95th birthday on Jan. 21, 2010. In 2009 Kiwanis clubs worldwide donated more than six million volunteer hours and raised more than US\$100 million for community service, with a special emphasis on helping young children.

The first Kiwanis club was chartered January 21, 1915, in Detroit, Mich. Today, Kiwanis has grown to more than 8,000 clubs and 240,000 members in 70 countries.
